The City of Little Rock has decided to allow the current Memorandum of Understanding to remain in place and forego the pursuit of a superseding contract. Thus, the City of Little Rock's relationship with Lime will terminate on May 15, 2019 pursuant to the MOU.

After much consideration it has been determined that it is in the best interests of our City to take this action. Although many people in our city have enjoyed your electric scooters, they are not without their problems and safety is a concern. The City has received numerous complaints about underage operators and safety provisions are largely lacking.

The City has been disappointed in Lime's lack of attention to the safety of its riders and pedestrians. The City truly hopes your company will address these issues and make the use of your electric scooters safer for everyone.
